

## How to set the MTU

To ensure optimal performance, it is recommended to set the Jumbo Frames on all the devices in your local network environment to MTU 9000

### Mac:

Open "System Preferences" → go to "Network" → Select the QNA Thunderbolt Ethernet → click "Advanced..." → go to the "Hardware" tab → change "Configure" to "Manually" → set "MTU" to "9000".

### Windows:

Open "Settings" → go to "Network & Internet" → click "Change your adapter options" → right click on the Thunderbolt 3 Ethernet adapter and click "Properties" → click "Configure..." → go to the "Advanced" tab → select "Jumbo Frame" and set the value to "9KB MTU".

### NAS:

Open "Network & Virtual Switch" → go to "Network" > "Interfaces" → find the applicable Ethernet adapter, click ≡ and select "Configure" → go to the "IPv4" tab → set "Jumbo Frame" to 9000.
