Operation of some of the functions of this unit is very complex. Because of this, it was deemed necessary to place these functions into a special screen. This will restrict operation of these functions to times when the vehicle is parked. This ensures the focus of the driver's attention will be on the road and not on the monitor. This has been done for the safety of the driver and passengers.

Setup Operation and Search Function cannot be made if the car is moving. The car must be parked and the parking brake must be engaged for the procedure described in the Owner's Manual to be valid. The warning "CAN'T OPERATE WHILE DRIVING," will be displayed if any attempts are made to perform these operations while driving.

- Be sure to disconnect the cable from the (-) battery post before installing your VPA-B211P/VPA-B211E. This will reduce any chance of damage to the unit in case of a short-circuit.
- Be sure to connect the colour coded leads according to the diagram. Incorrect connections may cause the unit to malfunction or damage to the vehicle's electrical system.
- When making connections to the vehicle's electrical system, be aware of the factory installed components (e.g. on-board computer). Do not tap into these leads to provide power for this unit. When connecting the VPA-B211P/VPA-B211E to the fuse box, make sure the fuse for the intended circuit of the VPA-B211P/VPA-B211E has the appropriate amperage. Failure to do so may result in damage to the unit and/or the vehicle. When in doubt, consult your ALPINE dealer.

Getting Started



Operation is carried out from the remote control.

Feature

If the unit is connected to an ALPINE Ai-NET compatible device (DVD/HDD Player, DVD/CD Changer, Adapter for iPod, etc.), operation with the supplied remote control can be carried out. You can also display the screen on the external monitor. If the unit is connected to an ALPINE navigation system, you can display navigation screens on the external monitor. For details on the function of connected devices, refer to the Owner's Manual.

When Using the Remote Control

- Point the remote control at the remote control eye within about 2 meters.
- It may not be possible to operate the remote control if the remote control eye is exposed to direct sunlight.
- The remote control is a small, lightweight precision device. To avoid damage, short battery life, operational errors and poor response, observe the following.
 - Do not subject the remote control to excessive shock.
 - Do not put in a trouser pocket.
 - Keep away from food, moisture and dirt.
 - Do not place in direct sunshine.
- Connect the supplied remote control eye. Failing to do so will result in a loss of remote control operation. Refer to "Connections" (pages 18).
- If an ALPINE monitor is connected as the external front monitor, connect the remote control input lead to the remote control output lead of the monitor. In this case, you do not need to connect the supplied remote control eye.

Battery Replacement

Applicable battery: Use two "AAA" sized dry batteries or equivalent.

1 Opening the battery cover

Slide out the battery cover while firmly pressing in the direction of the arrow.



2 Replacing the battery

Insert the batteries, observing the polarities as illustrated.



3 Closing the cover

Slide the cover as illustrated until a click is heard.



Turning Power On and Off

Some of this unit's functions cannot be performed while the vehicle is in motion. Be sure to stop your vehicle in a safe location and apply the parking brake, before attempting these operations.

Press **POWER** to turn on/off the unit.

Initial System Start-Up

Be sure to press the RESET button when using the unit for the first time, after installing the CD changer, after changing the car battery, etc.

1 Turn off the unit power.

2 Press **RESET** with a ball-point pen or similar pointed object.

Switching between NTSC and PAL

Set the output configuration to NTSC or PAL.

Press and hold **POWER** for at least 2 seconds.

• PAL is the standard and there is no need to change the setting. The system is set to PAL at time of shipment from the factory.

Lowering Volume Quickly

Activating this function will instantly lower the volume level.

Press MUTE.

No volume is output.

Pressing **MUTE** again brings the audio back to its previous level.

Switching a Source

Press SOURCE.

 Source can be switched by setting FRONT on the VIDEO SOURCE SEL screen. Refer to "Switching Each Monitor Source (VIDEO SOURCE SELECT Function)" (this page).

Other Useful Features



Switching Each Monitor Source (VIDEO SOURCE SELECT Function)

If the optional expansion box (VPE-S431) is connected, you can connect up to 2 external rear monitors.

The source is switched between the external front monitor and the external rear monitor using the VIDEO SOURCE SELECT function.

- **1** Press and hold MUTE for at least 2 seconds. The SETUP screen is displayed.
- 2 Press ▲ or ▼ to select VIDEO SOURCE SEL.
- 3 Press ►/II/SEARCH or ►►I. The VIDEO SOURCE SEL. screen is displayed.
- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select a monitor from which the source of FRONT/REAR 1/REAR 2 is set.

Switching the function of the remote sensor

The remote sensor of the external monitor can be switched, as you prefer.

Navigation Audio Interruption Volume Adjustment

With an Alpine navigation system connected to the VPA-B211P/VPA-B211E, the voice guidance of the navigation system will be mixed with the DVD or CD play. You can adjust the volume level of the voice guidance.

Setting item: NAV. MIX LEVEL

Setting contents: OFF, +1 to +15

• When NAV. is turned on, the setting can be made. Refer to "Setting the Navigation Mode" (this page).

Setting the Display Type

Depending on your external monitor, the screen may not be correctly displayed. In this case, change the type.

Setting item: DISPLAY-TYPE SEL. Setting contents: TYPE1 / TYPE2

Setting the Volume Level

The volume level can be set for each source.

Setting item: VOLUME LEVEL

Setting contents: LOW / MID / HIGH

• The sound level increases as follows: LOW \rightarrow MID \rightarrow HIGH.

Setting the Rear Camera

When the rear camera is connected, rear pictures are output on the screen.

Setting item: CAMERA-IN

Setting contents: OFF / ON

- ON: When the shift lever is set to reverse (R), the rear camera picture is shown on the screen. OFF: The rear pictures are not output.
- By shifting to reverse (R), the rear pictures are output. This function is effective when the reverse wire is properly connected.

Switching the Visual Input Signal (Rear Camera)

After setting to ON in "Setting the Rear Camera," then this setting may be carried out.

Setting item: CAMERA-IN SIG.

Setting contents: NTSC / PAL

• When ON is set in "Setting the Rear Camera" (this page), the setting can be made.

Setting the AUX Mode

Setting items: AUX IN-1 to 3 Setting contents: OFF / ON

OFF: AUX source is not displayed. ON: AUX source is displayed.

- OFF is not selected when the optional DVD player or DVD changer is connected.
- AUX IN-3 is adjustable when the external expansion box (VPE-S431) is connected.

Naming External Devices

When more than one external device is connected, you can name each (up to 3) as you like.

Setting item: AUX IN-1 to 3 NAME

Setting contents: AUX-1 (2, 3) / VCR / GAME-1, 2 / TV *1 / EXT-DVD / DVB-T*2

- The selected source name is displayed instead of AUX source name.

Adjusting the External Input Audio Level

Setting item: AUX IN-1 to 3 LEVEL Setting contents: LOW / HIGH

LOW: Decreases the external input audio level HIGH: Increases the external input audio level

Switching the Visual Input Signal (AUX)

After setting to ON in "Setting the AUX mode," then this setting may be carried out.

Setting item: AUX IN-1 to 3 SIG. Setting contents: NTSC / PAL

Setting the External Rear Monitor Output

Set it to ON when you use the external rear monitor.

Setting items: MONITOR OUT-1, 2 Setting contents: OFF / ON

- ON: By setting the connected external rear monitor to ON, the remote control will be usable.
- OFF: When either MONITOR OUT-1 or 2 is set to OFF, only one monitor can be set by the VIDEO SOURCE SELECT function.
- When the optional expansion box (VPE-S431) is connected, the setting can be made.

Setting the External Device Interrupt Mode

If an Alpine Versatile Link Terminal (KCA-410C) is connected to the VPA-B211P/VPA-B211E, an Auxiliary Source will be allowed to interrupt the current audio source. For example, you can listen to the voice guidance of your navigation system when it occurs even while you are playing a CD or DVD. The CD/DVD player will be automatically muted during voice guidance. For further details, please refer to the manual for KCA-410C.

Setting item: IN-INT. MUTE

Setting contents: OFF / ON

OFF:	Sound will be output in Interrupt mode.
ON:	Sound will not be output in Interrupt mode.

• The auxiliary device being connected must have an Interrupt wire with a negative trigger for this function to operate automatically. Otherwise, a separate switch needs to be added to switch it manually.

Setting the VISUALIZER Mode Display

Set VISUALIZER to your preference. Other than in the OFF setting, VISUALIZER can be displayed on the rear monitor. When you select SCAN, the screen shows a continuous series of 6 images, one after the other.

Setting item: VISUALIZER SEL.

Setting contents: MODE-1 to MODE-6 / SCAN / OFF

- When the optional expansion box (VPE-S431) is connected, the VISUALIZER setting can be made.
- To display VISUALIZER on the rear monitor, refer to "Switching Each Monitor Source (VIDEO SOURCE SELECT Function)" (page 5) and set the REAR 1 and REAR 2 sources to VISUALIZER.

Playing MP3/WMA Data

When using discs containing both CD data and MP3/WMA data.

Setting item: PLAY MODE

Setting content: CD-DA / CD/MP3

CD:	Plays only the CD data on discs containing
	both CD data and MP3/WMA data.
MP3:	Both CD data and MP3/WMA file tracks can
	be played back.

• Perform this setting before inserting a disc. If a disc has already been inserted, perform the setting after you remove the disc. If you use an MP3 changer, you have to change discs.

Setting the Scroll

Scroll display is available if titles are entered in the disc. Scroll display of CD text, folder names, file names and tag information is also enabled.

Setting item: AUTO SCROLL

Setting contents: AUTO / MANUAL

- AUTO: Turns on the AUTO scroll mode. Scroll display is repeated as long as the mode is turned on.
- MANUAL: Turns off the AUTO scroll mode. Scroll display is done once as a track is changed.

Switching Background Textures

You can select the background textures of the setup screen from 4 types.

Setting item: BACKGROUND SEL. Setting contents: TYPE1 to 4

Demonstration Function

This unit is equipped with a demonstration function capable of showing basic operations of respective sources on the display.

Setting item: DEMO Setting contents: OFF / ON

- ON: Turns on the demonstration mode to show the basic operations.
- OFF: Turns off the demonstration mode.
- The demonstration operation is automatically repeated until the function is turned off.

DVD/Video CD Operation (Optional)



Basic operations of an ALPINE DVD player/Changer compatible with Ai-NET can be done from the unit's supplied remote control. Refer to the Owner's Manual of the connected DVD player/Changer.

Playing DVD/Video CD

It is dangerous for the driver to watch the TV/DVD/ Video while driving the vehicle. The driver may be distracted from looking ahead and an accident could occur.

Install the VPA-B211P/VPA-B211E correctly so that the driver cannot watch TV/DVD/Video unless the vehicle is stopped and the emergency brake is applied.

If the VPA-B211P/VPA-B211E is not installed correctly, the driver will be able to watch the TV/ DVD/Video while driving the vehicle and may be distracted from looking ahead and cause an accident. The driver or other people could be severely injured.

- If you try to activate the auxiliary device while driving, the display will show the warning-PICTURE OFF FOR YOUR SAFETY.
- 1 Press SOURCE to activate the DVD mode. Playback starts.
- 2 Press either ▲ or ▼ to select a disc (DVD changer connected).

Fast-forwarding/Fast-reversing

- 1 During playback, press and hold I◄◀ (fast-reverse) or ►►I (fast-forward).
- 2 Release I ◄ or ►►I to return to normal playback.
